Mayor Saverino had the privilege of swearing in 3 new Police Officers this morning. They will be at the Cook County police training facility for 16 weeks.

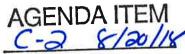

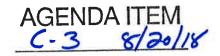

Agreement with Wayne Township - 27W031 North Avenue

BACKGROUND

The Village Board approved the annexation of the Wayne Township property at 27W031 North Avenue in January 2016. The annexation agreement, and special use and variation approvals, referenced the Township's specific plans for building additions and site and landscaping improvements that they intended to construct. The Township did not proceed with the building additions or site improvements, and have decided to revise the plans. Because the approvals granted in 2016 were specific to the Township's plans at the time, the Township is required to seek new approvals including an amendment to the annexation agreement, an amendment to the special use permit, and new variations.

At its July 23, 2018 meeting, the Plan Commission/Zoning Board of Appeals (PC/ZBA) recommended approval of most of the Township's revised requests, including an amendment to the special use, variations, and North Avenue Corridor Review. However, by a 3-3 vote, the PC/ZBA did not recommend approval of the Township's request for relief from the Zoning Code requirement for curbed landscape islands in the front parking lot as part of the parking lot improvement plans. With a 3-3 vote on the motion, this aspect of the Township's application will come before the Village Board with no PC/ZBA recommendation.

DISCUSSION

The amendment to the annexation agreement requires the Village Board to hold a public hearing. Staff arranged for publication of the required public notice to enable the Board to conduct the public hearing at the meeting on August 20th. The Village Attorney has advised that while the Village Board should hold the public hearing and accept any public comment, the Board should not take action on the amendment to the agreement until after the Wayne Township Board approves the amendment. The next Wayne Township Board meeting is September 6, and so staff would intend to have all of the ordinances ready for Village Board action at the Board's September 17 meeting.

Although the attached Draft Amendment to the Annexation Agreement is substantially in final form, staff is requesting that the Village Board provide

direction regarding the two outstanding issues, described below, at the August 20 meeting. With the Board's direction on these issues, the Draft Amendment to the Annexation Agreement can be finalized for action by the Township Board on September 6 and the Village Board on September 17.

Curbed Landscape Islands – As mentioned, the Zoning Code requires parking lot greenspace to be provided in the form of curbed landscape islands. Wayne Township has requested a variation for a significant reduction in parking lot greenspace, and proposes to install painted or striped "islands" on the asphalt in the front parking lot as shown on the attached landscape plan. Staff continues to recommend that actual curbed landscape islands be provided at both ends of the row of parking along the North Avenue frontage, not only to provide required greenspace, but also because curbed landscape islands more effectively channel and direct traffic than do painted asphalt islands. The Township is expected to present its request to not install curbed landscape islands at the meeting on August 20.

Construction Completion Date – To provide certainty regarding the completion of the Township's building addition and site improvement project, staff recommended a condition that the project be completed by November 1, 2019. This condition of approval was recommended by the PC/ZBA and is stipulated in the Draft Amendment to the Annexation Agreement. Although the Township did not object to this condition at the PC/ZBA meeting, in subsequent conversations with the Township Attorney, the Township is now requesting that the deadline for the building additions and site improvements be moved back to June 1, 2020, to allow for construction contingencies. Staff does not object to this change, and if the Village Board is agreeable, we will modify this provision in the Draft Amendment to the Annexation Agreement.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends that the Village Board open the public hearing, accept any public comment, and then close the public hearing. Staff also requests that the Village Board provide direction regarding the parking lot landscape islands and the date for completion of the project by the Township. As noted, with the Board's direction on these items, staff would finalize the Draft Amendment to the Annexation Agreement for approval by the Wayne Township Board, and prepare all of the required ordinances for action by the Village Board at its meeting on September 17, 2018.

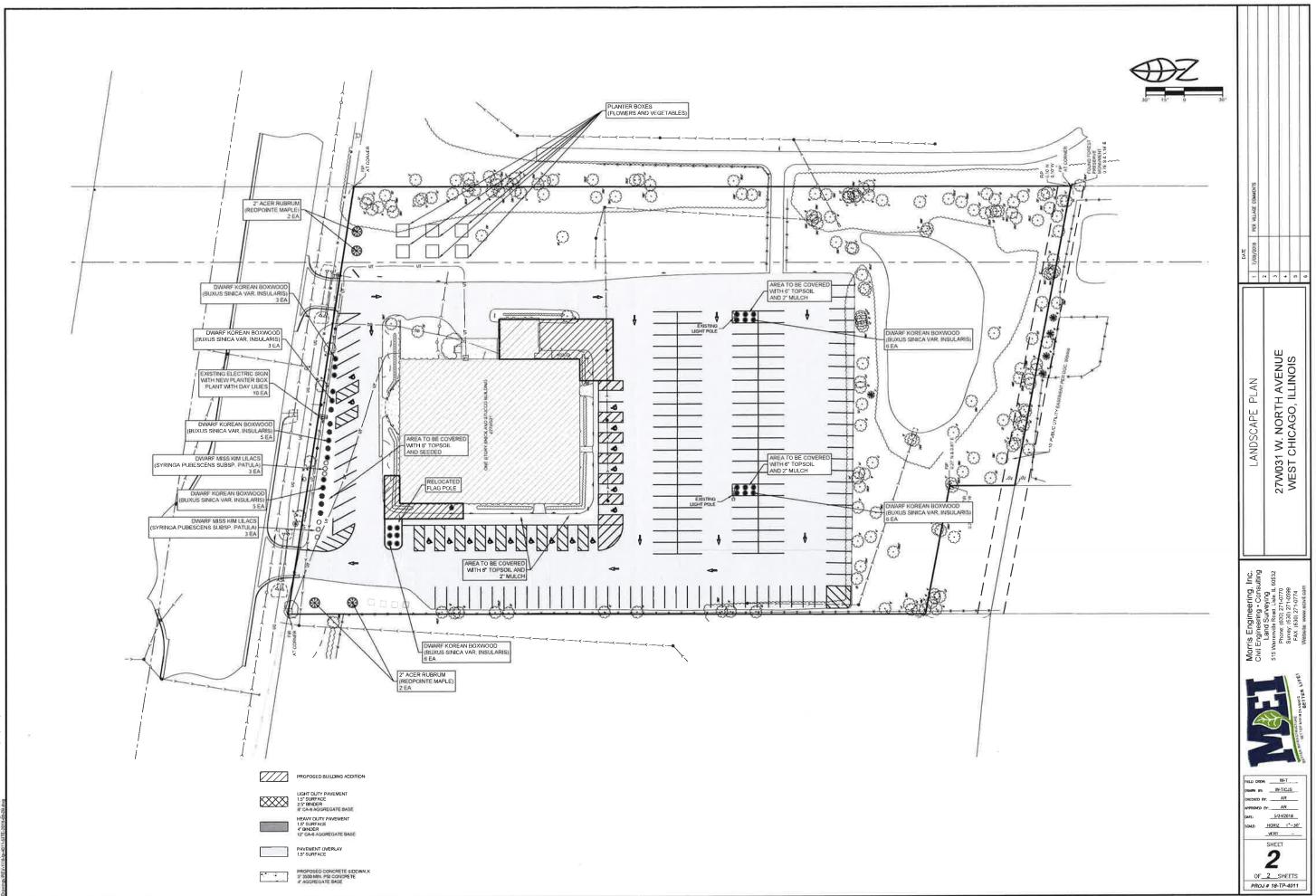

Signage, and Temporary Sign and Tent Permit Fee Waiver

PURPOSE

The purpose of this memorandum is to coordinate with the Village Board a request from the Carol Stream Animal Hospital, located at 140 Elk Trail, for approval of a temporary waiver from the requirements of the Sign Code to allow for the temporary placement of five off-site banners to promote the upcoming Carol Stream Charity Dog Show event at the Ross Ferraro Town Center, in addition to a request to waive permit fees associated with said banners and a large tent at the event.

REQUEST

Attached is a letter from Dr. Mondrian Contreras with the Carol Stream Animal Hospital, requesting approval to install temporary banners at five locations between September 1, 2018 and September 23, 2018, to promote the Carol Stream Dog Charity event that will be held at Town Center on Sunday, September 23, 2018. As discussed at the May 7, 2018 Village Board meeting, the proposed event will take the place of the annual CS Barks event that the Carol Stream Park District previously held. The event will be held from 10:00am to 4:00pm on September 23rd, and will include a variety of dog competitions and vendor displays. The submitted aerial photograph illustrates the proposed setup for the event, and additional information on the event is available on the animal hospital's website, www.carolstreamah.com. The applicant has also obtained approval from the property owner at CSC/Wesco at 200 E. Lies Road for volunteer and visitor off-site parking.

The Sign Code allows entities to install temporary signs advertising special events. These signs, usually banners, may remain in place for up to 30 days, and may not exceed 32 square feet in area. The intent is that these signs are to be installed on the property at which the special event will be held. As indicated in Dr. Contreras' letter, the Carol Stream Animal Hospital wishes to install the five banners off-site at the following Park District properties:

- Barbara O'Rahilly Volunteer Park at 302 N. Kuhn Road
- Veteran's Park at 200 W. Lies Road
- Hampe Park at 297 W. Lies Road

- Red Hawk Park at 651 W. St. Charles Road
- Bark Park at 280 Kuhn Road

The proposed banners are 32 square feet in area (four feet tall by eight feet wide), will be secured to the ground by posts, and will be placed a minimum of five feet from the property line to comply with Sign Code requirements.

To allow for the installation of the five off-site special event banners, a variation from §6-11-9(G) (*Temporary Business Event Signs*) of the Sign Code is necessary. Although the Plan Commission/Zoning Board of Appeals (PC/ZBA) would usually review and make a recommendation regarding Sign Code variation requests, the Village Board may grant a temporary waiver to the Sign Code, in accordance with the provisions of §1-1-17 of the Code of Ordinances, to allow for the installation of the five off-site banners. The banners will be installed on a temporary basis for 23 days, and so a permanent variation is not necessary. In addition, the request is similar to requests for previous special events held at Town Center such as Relay for Life, Just Play, CS Barks, and Bud's Run.

The Carol Stream Animal Hospital also requests a waiver of permit fees for the banners and a 20 foot x 40 foot tent that will be installed at Town Center, specifically at the check-in area for the event (see submitted aerial photograph). It should be noted that other small tents (10 feet x 10 feet in size) will be installed in the west field for vendors; however, permits are not required for small "popup" tents (staff will work with the event organizer regarding the spacing requirements for the popup tents).

In making the request for a waiver of the temporary sign and tent permit fees, Dr. Mondrian has explained that there is a limited budget to allocate toward costs associated with administering the Charity Dog Show event. Staff estimates that the permit fees would be \$380 (\$130 for the temporary banners and \$250 for the tent). It is not uncommon for the Village to waive certain fees, such as raffle license and amplification permit fees, for community organizations or other governmental agencies. However, the waiver of building and zoning permit fees, which are greater in cost and cover the Village's cost of providing services, is usually only done for governmental agencies. Exceptions to this practice have been the waiving of building permit fees for events like Relay for Life and Bud's Run, which were also held at Town Center. Two other points are worth noting. As mentioned, the charity event will take the place of the annual CS Barks event that the Park District previously held at Town Center. In addition, the animal hospital is enrolled in the American Veterinary Medical Foundation (AVMF) Veterinary Care Charitable Fund, which allows for low or nocost services to clients facing hardships as well as supporting animals rescued from abuse and neglect, and participants in the charity event are able to donate to the Fund.

STAFF ANALYSIS

Staff recognizes the Carol Stream Animal Hospital's interest in informing the public about the special event that will be held on September 23rd. The temporary waiver the Village Board is being asked to approve is to allow five off-site banners to be installed for 23 days, along with a waiver of building

permit fees associated with the banners and large tent. The Village Board has historically approved similar requests for the promotion of other events, such as Just Play, CS Barks, Relay for Life, and Bud's Run. In view of the temporary nature of the banners and the need to inform the public about the event, staff supports the temporary waiver to the Code of Ordinances to allow the off-site banners. In addition, staff can support the waiver of building permit fees for the banners and large tent.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends approval of the Carol Stream Animal Hospital's request for a temporary waiver to the Sign Code to allow for the installation of temporary banners for the Charity Dog Show, and a waiver of building permit fees associated with the banners and large tent. If the Village Board concurs with staff's recommendation, they should approve, by motion, a temporary variation from the Sign Code to allow the five off-site special event banners, and a waiver of permit fees for the banners and large tent, subject to the following conditions:

- 1. That the Carol Stream Animal Hospital must obtain a temporary sign permit for the banners and a tent permit prior to the installation of the banners and large tent, and that an inspection of the tent shall occur prior to the event;
- 2. That the five banners will be installed between September 1, 2018 and September 23, 2018 at the Barbara O'Rahilly Volunteer Park, Veteran's Park, Redhawk Park, Hampe Park, and the Dog Park, and removed by September 24, 2018;
- 3. That the banners must be maintained in good condition for the duration of their installation;
- 4. That the banners must be installed and maintained in a manner that does not present visibility obstructions for motorists, and must not be installed within the sight-visibility triangle; and
- 5. That all signage and the tent must comply with all applicable state, county and village codes and requirements.

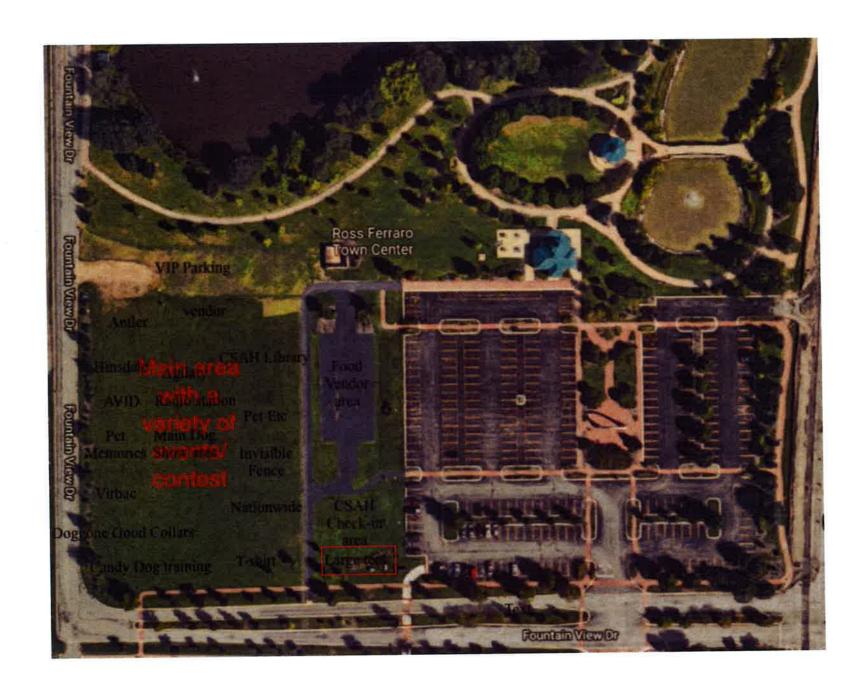

The low bid received was under the Engineer's Estimate of \$67,000.00 by \$17,100.00 (26%).

A total of \$537,000.00 is budgeted between the Pavement Rejuvenator Project, the Restorative Sealer Project and the Patching Project. After awarding the first two projects, the budget remaining for the Patching Project is \$107,000.00.

Although the low bidder, Chicagoland Paving Contractors, Inc., has not worked for the Village in the past, I have completed similar projects successfully with this contractor. Staff therefore recommends award of the contract to Chicagoland Paving Contractors, Inc. at the bid unit prices submitted.

PC/ZBA Case 18-0013, LA Fitness – 470 E. North Avenue, Amendment to a Special Use Permit for a PUD, Final PUD Plan Approval, North Avenue Corridor Review Approval

As presented at the August 6, 2018 Village Board meeting, Robertino Presta with 520 E. North Avenue LLC requests approval of an Amendment to a Special Use Permit for a Planned Unit Development (PUD), a Final PUD Plan, and North Avenue Corridor (NAC) Review for a proposed LA Fitness at the Carol Stream Marketplace at 470 E. North Avenue. The applicant also requests approval of four exemptions as part of the Final PUD Plan: a seven-space parking reduction, a reduction of the front building setback from 100 feet to 48.5 feet along North Avenue, an increase in wall signage letter size from 30 inches to 40 inches, and a deviation from the approved building elevations for the PUD. As discussed at the August 6th meeting, staff was supportive of the Special Use Amendment, Final PUD Plan, and NAC Review with most of the requested exemptions, but was not initially supportive of the request to deviate from the approved building materials and elevations for the PUD.

The PUD Plan for the Carol Stream Marketplace established architectural and signage standards for outlot buildings, specifically requiring brick and stone as the exterior building materials, with stone detailing and decorative cornices to visually enhance all buildings within the PUD. Attached are photos of the existing Caputo's and outlot buildings, along with the approved elevations for the outlot buildings for reference. LA Fitness initially proposed a different building design than the rest of the center, with the use of off-white precast concrete panels, painted concrete panels with a form liner to emulate masonry along the lower portion of the building, an EIFS cornice that was of a different design than the EIFS cornices found on the other buildings in the center, and other decorative features including canopies and prefinished vertical metal siding wall elements. At the meeting on August 6th, the Village Board directed the applicant to revise the building elevations to more closely resemble the materials and design standards required under the PUD. After the August 6th meeting, staff also provided the following recommendations to the applicant so that the building elevations would better reflect the Village Board's direction:

- Paint the upper 14 feet of the precast panels a beige color to match the beige brick on the other shopping center buildings
- Paint the lower seven feet of the precast panels with the masonry form liner a lighter color to match the stone on the other shopping center buildings
- Paint a band along the middle portion of the building facades to match the masonry band on the other shopping center buildings
- Match the decorative cornice on the other shopping center buildings
- All of these elements should be provided on all four sides of the LA Fitness building

The applicant has provided updated building elevations which illustrate staff's recommendations and reflect the Board's direction. A PUD exemption still needs to be approved to deviate from the previously approved building elevations, but staff believes the revised plans represent a more consistent appearance with the rest of the Carol Stream Marketplace and can support the exemption.

The staff report presenting the request, with supporting documentation, was transmitted to the Village Board with the PC/ZBA packet on July 20, 2018. At its meeting on July 23, 2018, by a vote of 4-1 with one member abstaining, the PC/ZBA recommended approval of the Amendment to the Special Use Permit for a PUD, Final PUD Plan, and North Avenue Corridor Review subject to the conditions in the July 23, 2018 staff report.

If the Village Board believes that the exterior building elevations have been revised to sufficiently blend with the rest of the Carol Stream Marketplace from an architectural perspective, they should approve the Special Use Amendment and Final PUD Plan for LA Fitness subject to the conditions contained within the Ordinance, and adopt the necessary Ordinance. It should be noted that no Village Board action is necessary regarding the North Avenue Corridor Review.

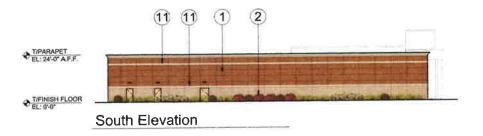

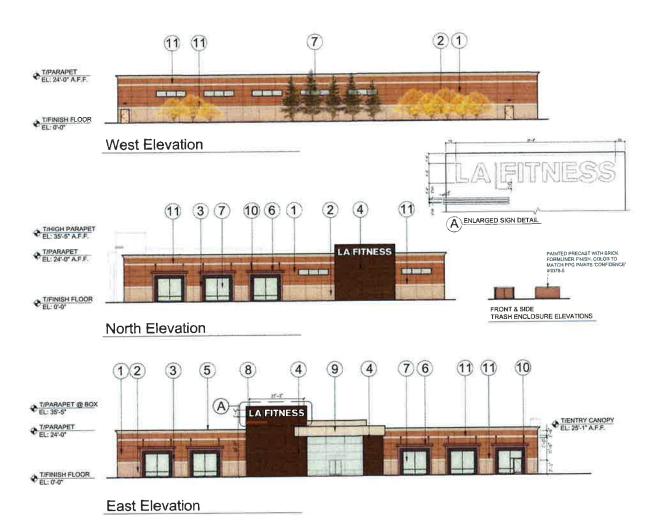






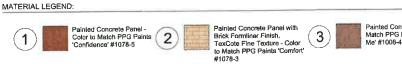
Building Elevations Revised Following August 6 Village Board Meeting

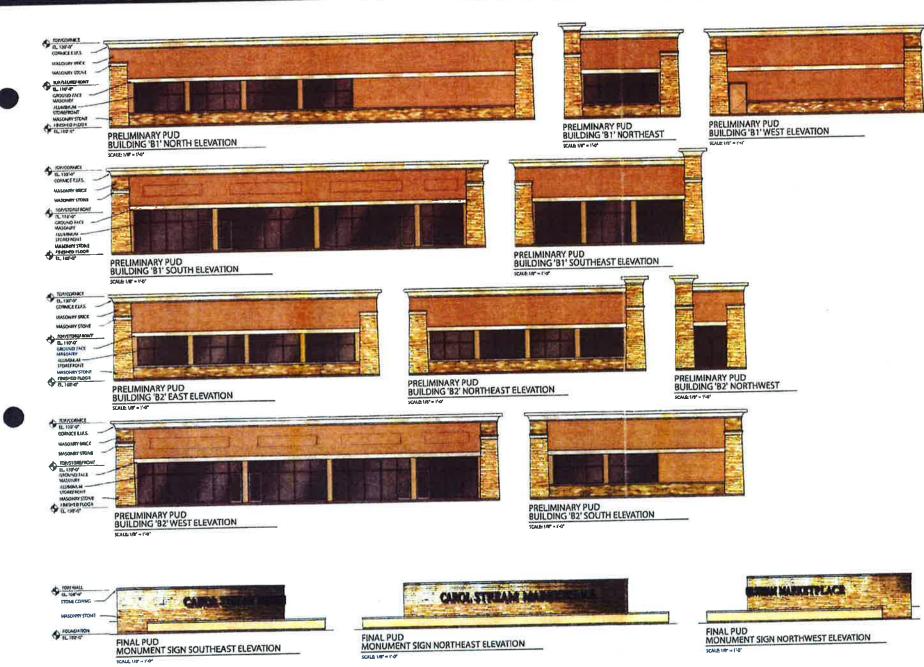

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ORDINANCE NO. 2018-___-

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AN AMENDMENT TO A SPECIAL USE PERMIT FOR A PLANNED UNIT DEVELOPMENT AND A FINAL PUD PLAN (LA FITNESS, 470 E. NORTH AVENUE)

WHEREAS, Robertino Presta with 520 E. North Avenue, LLC and on behalf of LA Fitness, hereinafter referred to as the Petitioner, has petitioned the Village of Carol Stream for an Amendment to Special Use Permit for a Planned Unit Development in accordance with Sections 16-9-3 (C)(1) and 16-9-2 (C)(1) of the Carol Stream Code of Ordinances; and Final PUD Approval for a 34,000 square foot fitness center in accordance with Section 16-16-4 of the Carol Stream Code of Ordinances, on the property legally described in Section 2 herein and commonly known as 470 E. North Avenue, Carol Stream, Illinois; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 16-15-8 of the Carol Stream Code of Ordinances, the Combined Plan Commission/Zoning Board of Appeals held a public hearing on the above petition on July 23, 2018, following proper legal notice of said public hearing, after which the Commission recommended to the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Village that the Amendment to a Special Use Permit and Final PUD Plan be approved; and

WHEREAS, the Combined Plan Commission/Zoning Board of Appeals has filed its Findings and Recommendations regarding the Amendment to a Special Use Permit and Final PUD Plan with the Mayor and Board of Trustees, and the Mayor and Board of Trustees have duly considered said Findings and Recommendations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CAROL STREAM, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, IN THE EXERCISE OF ITS HOME RULE POWERS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1:

The Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Village of Carol Stream, after examining the Petition for the Amendment to a Special Use Permit for a Planned Unit Development and a Final PUD Plan and the Findings and Recommendations of the Combined Plan Commission/Zoning Board of Appeals, have determined and find that the requested Special Use Permit:

- 1. Is deemed necessary for the public convenience at the location. The proposed fitness center will provide another recreational locale for residents in the community.
- 2. Will not be unreasonably detrimental to or endanger the public health, safety, morals, comfort or general welfare. The requested Special Use Amendment should not be detrimental to or endanger public health, safety, morals, comfort or general welfare.
- 3. Will not be injurious to the use and enjoyment of other property in the immediate vicinity for the purposes already permitted, nor substantially diminish and impair property values within the neighborhood. The proposed fitness center should not be injurious to the use and enjoyment of other property in the immediate vicinity, nor substantially diminish or impair property values within the neighborhood.

- 4. Will not impede the normal and orderly development and improvement of surrounding property for uses permitted in the district. It is not believed that there should be an impact on the normal and orderly development and improvement of surrounding properties in the immediate vicinity with the approval of the proposed fitness center, which may also spur development of other outlots at the Carol Stream Marketplace.
- 5. Will provide adequate utilities, access roads, drainage and other important and necessary community facilities. *Adequate utilities*, access roads, drainage and other public improvements are already in place.
- 6. Will conform to the applicable regulations of the district in which it is located, except as the Village Board may in each instance modify such regulations. *The proposal is expected to conform to all applicable codes and requirements.*

SECTION 2:

The Amendment to a Special Use Permit and Final PUD Plan, as set forth in the above recitals, are hereby approved and granted to LA Fitness subject to the conditions set forth in Section 3, upon the real estate commonly known as 470 E. North Avenue, Carol Stream, Illinois, and legally described as follows:

LOT 1 IN DUDA'S FIRST RESUBDIVISION, BEING A SUBDIVISION OF PART OF THE SOUTHWEST ¼ OF SECTION 33, TOWNSHIP 40 NORTH, RANGE 10, EAST OF THE THIRD PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, AND PART OF THE NORTHWEST ¼ OF SECTION 4, TOWNSHIP 39 NORTH, RANGE 10, EAST OF THE THIRD PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, ACCORDING TO THE PLAT THEREOF RECORDED JULY 6, 2006, AS DOCUMENT R2006-128930, IN DUPAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS.

hereinafter referred to as the Subject Property.

SECTION 3:

The approval of the Amendment to a Special Use Permit and Final PUD Plan granted in Section 1 herein are subject to the following conditions:

- 1. That all terms and conditions of Ordinance No. 2012-08-29 for the Carol Stream Marketplace not specifically revised herein shall be hereby reaffirmed by reference;
- 2. That all improvements, including but limited to the building, parking lot, and landscaping, must be built, installed, and maintained in accordance with the attached plans and exhibits;
- 3. That the landscape materials must be installed as shown on the attached landscape plan (except as may be amended to address recommended conditions herein), and that all materials shall be maintained in a healthy condition, with

dead or dying materials being replaced in accordance with the approved plan on an annual basis;

- 4. That if there is evidence in the future that there is insufficient on-site parking for LA Fitness, or there is a need for the installation of the fire lane on the west side of the property, said fire lane and landbanked parking denoted on the Preliminary PUD Site Plan shall be constructed by the property owner;
- 5. That a note shall be placed on the landscape plan that the existing small monument sign along the North Avenue property frontage shall be removed and landscaping shall be installed in its place to continue the required screening of the parking lot;
- 6. That parking spaces must be striped in accordance with the Village's looped striping detail;
- 7. That parking lot lighting for the parking lot must comply with the Village Code requirements for foot-candle illumination, and match lighting in the rest of the center in terms of style;
- 8. That all trash dumpsters and recycling containers must be kept within a code compliant trash enclosure, and that the enclosure gates must be closed and latched at all times, except when trash containers are being accessed by employees or emptied by the trash collection service;
- 9. That rooftop mounted mechanical equipment must be screened from view in all directions from adjacent public streets and drive aisles;
- 10. That the applicant or owner must install additional landscape materials in the future, subject to the approval of the Community Development Director, to screen yet-unknown ground-mounted mechanical and utility equipment; and
- 11. That the site must be maintained and the business must be operated in accordance with all State, County and Village codes and regulations.

SECTION 4:

The Amendment to the Special Use Permit and Final PUD Plan are hereby approved and granted as set forth in the following plans and exhibits:

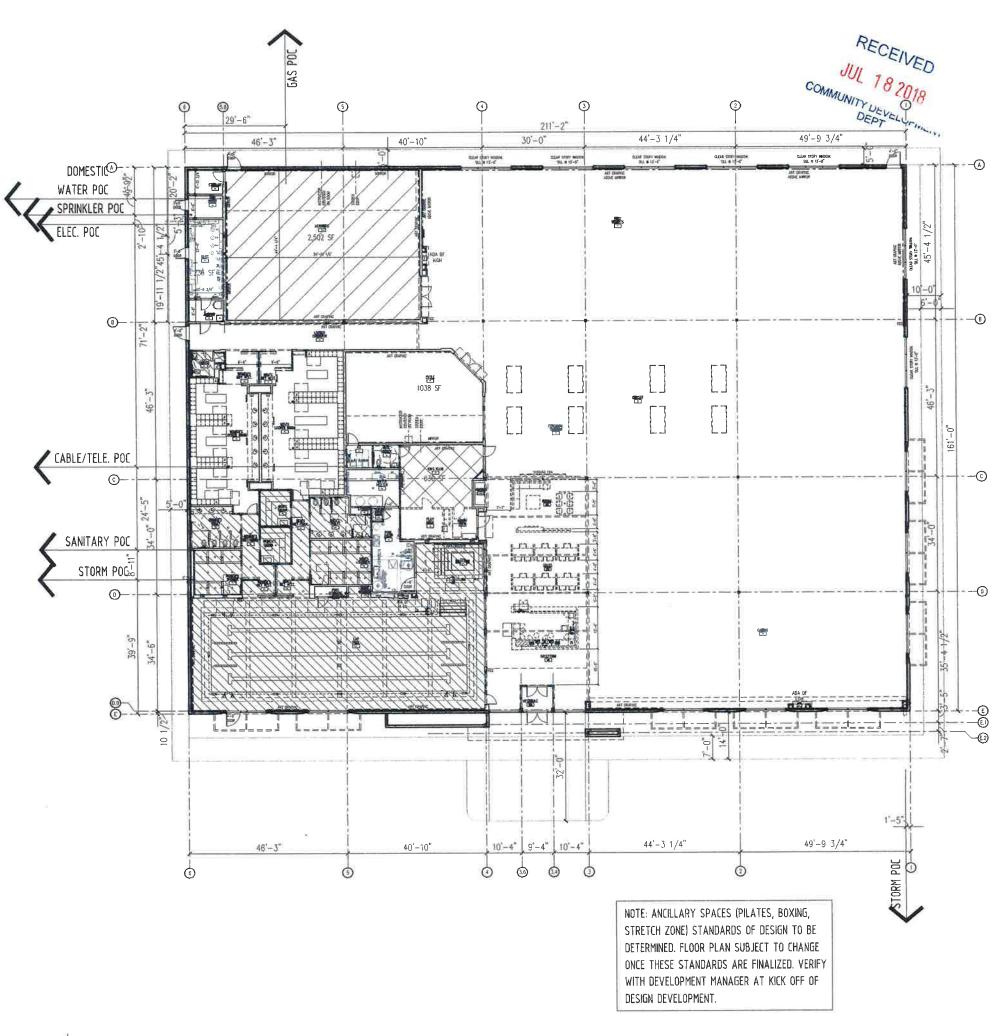

RE: Resolution Accepting the DuPage County Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan

Approximately every five years the Village participates in the updating of the DuPage County Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan (DPC-NHMP). Village staff from Engineering, Public Works, Police as well as the Fire Protection District took part in the update starting back in November of 2017. The NHMP was completed and sent to the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) on January 22, 2018 and subsequently approved July 23, 2018. DuPage County adopted the NHMP on June 23, 2018 paving the way for municipalities to adopt it.

The NHMP is a document that guides municipalities through a series of action items toward mitigating damages caused by natural hazards. Municipalities are also required to have a NHMP in effect in order to receive federal mitigation grant funds. The DPC-NHMP meets the requirements of the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000, the Stafford Act and 44CFR Part 78.5 for FEMA's Disaster Mitigation Program and the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program. In the past, the Village has received funding from both of these programs.

The Village is required to appoint a representative to serve on the DuPage County Natural Hazards Mitigation Work Group (Work Group). With the adoption of this resolution, the Village appoints Deputy Police Chief John Jungers as our official representative. He will periodical apprise the Directors of the DuPage County Stormwater Management Department and the Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Management on our hazard mitigation progress.

The attached resolution was worded in such a way to accept the NHMP as a useful guidance document for the Village to pursue hazard activities agreed to by the Village Board rather than a wholesale adoption. In the past, there has been an interest by the County to adopt a stormwater utility fee. We didn't want the adoption of this plan to be misconstrued as an endorsement of a stormwater utility fee. We also didn't want an adoption of this plan to lessen the Village Board's role and autonomy as a full and equal partner in advancing hazard mitigation strategies. Therefore, the resolution has been drafted as an acceptance of the plan.

Staff have reviewed the NHMP and resolution and found it satisfactory. We recommend the Village Board adopt the resolution accepting the DPC-NHMP, which can be viewed on the County's web site at https://www.dupageco.org/OHSEM/ProtectDuPage/56263/.

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE DUPAGE COUNTY MUNICIPAL HAZARDS MITIGATION PLAN

WHEREAS, the Village of Carol Stream is subject to natural hazards, such as, floods, severe summer and winter storms tornadoes, extreme heat events; and

WHEREAS, natural hazards can damage property, close businesses, disrupt traffic, can threaten lives, and present public health and safety hazards; and

WHEREAS, the DuPage County Natural Hazards Mitigation Workgroup has prepared the DuPage County Natural Hazards Mitigation Plan (Plan) that prioritized 8 goals and 6 guidelines as well as detailing 12 action items that will help the Village, in partnership with DuPage County government and the private sector when necessary to support the overall goal of protecting the lives, health, safety of citizens as well as the critical facilities that allow the Village to provide essential public services to its residents; and

WHEREAS, the Village has participated in the development of the Plan which began in November 2017 and was completed and submitted to the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) for approval on January 22, 2018 and subsequently approved this past July 23, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the recommended Plan has been presented for review by residents, federal, state and regional agencies and adopted by DuPage County on June 12, 2018.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE BOAD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CAROL STREAM, DUPAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, IN THE EXERCISE OF ITS HOME RULE POWERS, as follows:

SECTION 1: The Plan identifies a series of action items that will help focus our efforts as a municipal partner to further our work toward mitigating hazards in our community from likely natural disasters.

<u>SECTION 2</u>: The Plan is hereby accepted as a guideline to help advance specific and targeted hazard mitigation efforts the Corporate Authorities approve and for which budgeted or grant funds have been appropriated.

SECTION 3: In accepting the Plan strictly as a useful resource for undertaking select local hazard mitigation efforts in the foreseeable future, the Village will coordinate its efforts with DuPage County government, the Carol Stream Fire Protection District and the private sector whenever and wherever partnership efforts are needed to advance selected project(s) identified in the Plan.

SECTION 4: By accepting this Plan as a framework for future hazard mitigation planning efforts, the Village, is in no manner endorsing DuPage County government's effort to establish a storm water utility nor is it surrendering its local autonomy to DuPage County to establish its own priorities in adopting hazard mitigation projects it deems essential to the betterment of the Carol Stream community.

SECTION 5: Deputy Police Chief John Jungers is hereby appointed as the Village's representative on the DuPage County Natural Hazards Mitigation Workgroup. Periodically, the Village's official representative on the county-wide Hazard Mitigation Team will appraise the Directors of the DuPage County Stormwater Management Department and the Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Management on local progress made that advances hazard mitigation efforts in the Carol Stream community.

<u>SECTION 6</u>: A copy of the Plan will be on file in the Village Clerk's office and linked on the Village's web site for public reference.

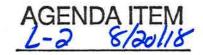
