Policy for Quality Based Selection (QBS) of Consultants on Contracts

Using Federal Funding for Consultant Payment

In August of 2017, the Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) changed its policy regarding consultant selection to comply with federal QBS requirements. Previously, a home rule community could refer to an "established relationship" to select a consultant. The new policy raised many questions related to the Chapter 5 (Agreements) section of the IDOT Bureau of Local Roads and Streets (BLRS) Policy Manual.

On November 29, 2017, a rewrite of Chapter 5 was issued by IDOT to clarify the new requirements. One of the requirements of the new policy manual is to have written procedures in place for the selection of consultants following specific IDOT criteria. IDOT requires no review of these procedures as long as they follow the guidelines outlined in Chapter 5 of the BLRS Policy Manual.

The Village Attorney has reviewed the document drafted by Engineering Staff and recommends that the Village Board officially adopt the Policies and Procedures. No Village Code change is needed since the code does not reference conflicting QBS requirements.

Engineering staff therefore recommends that the attached Village of Carol Stream Policies and Procedures for Quality Based Selection of Consultants using Federal Funding be officially adopted by the Village Board.

Village of Carol Stream Policies & Procedures for Ouality Based Selection (QBS) of Consultants using Federal Funding

Village of Carol Stream receives federal funds, which may be used to fund the engineering and design related consultant services. Our written policies and procedures as describe herein for QBS will meet the requirements of 23 CFR 172 and the Brooks Act.

- 1. <u>Initial Administration</u> Village of Carol Stream QBS policy and procedures assigns responsibilities to the following Village Engineer and/or designees within Village of Carol Stream organization for the procurement, management, and administration for consultant services.
- 2. <u>Written Policies and Procedures</u> Village of Carol Stream believes their adopted QBS written policies and procedures substantially follows Section 5-5 of the BLRS Manual and specifically Section 5-5.06(e), therefore; approval from IDOT is not required.
- 3. <u>Project Description</u> Village of Carol Stream will use the following five items when developing the project description and may include additional items when unique circumstances exist.
 - Describe in general terms the need, purpose, and objective of the project;
 - Identify the various project components;
 - Establish the desired timetable for the effort;
 - Identify any expected problems
 - Determine the total project budget.
- 4. Public Notice Village of Carol Stream will post an announcement on our website www.carolstream.org and/or publish an ad in a newspaper with appropriate circulation. The item will be advertised for at least 14 days prior to the acceptance of proposals, and at least twice in the newspaper and/or on continuous display on our website.
- 5. <u>Conflict of Interest</u> Village of Carol Stream require consultants to submit a disclosure statement with their procedures. Village of Carol Stream require the use of the IDOT BDE DISC 2 Template as their conflict of interest form.
- 6. <u>Suspension and Debarment</u> Village of Carol Stream will make use of SAM Exclusions, IDOT's CPO's website and the three other state CPO's websites to verify suspensions and debarments actions to ensure the eligibility of firms short listed and selected for projects.
- 7. Evaluation Factors Village of Carol Stream allows the following Village Engineer and/or designee to set the evaluation factors for each project, but must include a minimum of 8 criterion and stay within the established weighting range. The maximum of DBE and local presence combined will not be more that 10% on projects where federal funds are used. The following Project specific evaluation factors will be included at a minimum in the Request for Proposals;
 - Technical Approach (10 30%)
 - Firm Experience (10 30%)
 - Specialized Expertise (10 30%)
 - Staff Capabilities (Prime/Sub) (10 30%)
 - Work Load Capacity (10 -30%)
 - Past performance (10 30%)

In addition there are two nominal non-qualifications based criteria for evaluation. They are limited to a combined weights of 10% or less:

- In-State or Local Presence (0 10%)
- Participation of Qualified and Certified DBE Sub-consultants (0-10%)
- 8. <u>Selection</u> Village of Carol Stream requires a minimum of three person selection committee. Typically the selection committee members include the Village Engineer and designees. The selection committee members must certify that they do not have a conflict of interest. Selection committee members are chosen by the Village Engineer for each project. Village of Carol Stream require each member of the selection committee to provide an independent score for each proposal using the form below prior to the selection committee meeting.

The selection committee members' scores are averaged for a committee score which is used to establish a short list of three firms. The committee score is adjusted by the committee based on group discussion and information gained from presentations and interviews to develop a final ranking. If there are other firms within [2%] of the minimum score, the Village Engineer or designee may choose to expand the short list to include more than three firms.

- 9. Independent Estimate Village of Carol Stream will prepare an independent in-house estimate for the project prior to contract negotiation. The estimate is used in the negotiation.
- 10. Contract Negotiation Village of Carol Stream requires a three person team to negotiate with firms. The team consists of Village Engineer or designee. Members of the negotiation team may delegate this responsibility to staff members.
- 11. Acceptable Costs Village of Carol Stream requires the Project Manager to review the contract costs and the indirect cost rates to assure they are compliant with Federal cost principles prior to submission to IDOT.
- 12. Invoice Processing Village of Carol Stream requires the Project Manager assigned to any project using federal funds to review and approve all invoices prior to payment and submission to IDOT for reimbursement.
- 13. Project Administration Village of Carol Stream requires the assigned Project Manager to monitor work on the project in accordance with the contract and to file reports with the Village Engineer or designee. The Village of Carol Stream procedures require an evaluation of the consultant's work at the end of each project. These reports are maintained in Village of Carol Stream consultant information database. Village of Carol Stream follows IDOT's requirements and the required submission of BLRS Form 05613 to the IDOT district at contract close-out along with the final invoice.

Engineering has received final waivers and we are now recommending final payment be made for the referenced project. Motor Fuel Tax funds were used for this project; therefore, IDOT documents are required.

This project was completed for \$3,108,204.51. It was \$691,795.49 (18.2%) under the budget amount of \$3,800,000.00 and \$289,957.48 (8.5%) under the contract (\$3,398,161.99) based on actual field measured quantities.

Project savings included sidewalk removal and replacement, base patching repairs and asphalt level binder.

Engineering staff therefore recommends the balancing change order be approved, approval of final payment in the amount of \$65,216.21 be made to Plote Construction, Inc. and acceptance of the public improvements for the 2017 Flexible Pavement Project.

for Additional Data Extraction

In September of 2016, the Village awarded a contract to IMS to inventory pavement conditions and capture the location and image of trees, streetlights, signs, curbs, sidewalks and other roadside objects. A negotiated fee schedule was approved by the Northeast Illinois Partnering Consortium (NIPC) to reduce costs by combining work with other communities.

To keep the project within the 2016 budget of \$73,000, engineering staff chose to extract only pavement related data to import to our GIS and Cartegraph systems. This also allowed staff time to develop processes and procedures so that the data is accurate and useful. We are now in the position to extract additional data related to concrete curb and gutter, and street signs and supports.

The cost to complete this additional data extraction is \$25,935 and is within the budget of \$27,000. The schedule to complete the right of way asset database development is within 60 days of the Notice to Proceed.

Engineering staff therefore recommends award of the contract for data extraction of curb and gutter and signs and supports to Infrastructure Management Systems at a cost of \$25,935, pursuant to Sections 5-8-3(B) and 5-8-14(A) of the Carol Stream Code of Ordinances.

Traffic Code Changes for Cloverdale School

The Police Department recently received complaints from residents about traffic problems on Stonewood Circle related to student pick up. Drivers are waiting for children on both sides of the street west of Merbach Drive, impeding two-way traffic on Stonewood Circle.

To resolve the problem, it is recommended that parking be prohibited on the north side of Stonewood Circle between Merbach Drive and Kildare Court, during drop-off and pick up hours on school days. This will allow traffic room to maneuver at the intersection of Merbach Drive and Stonewood Circle.



The Chamber of Commerce has submitted a request for six to seven split the pot raffles at its monthly luncheons. In addition to the proposed split the pot raffles, the Chamber holds a Reverse raffle and a raffle at their Holiday Social. The total number of raffles to be held eight to nine.

The Code of Ordinances provides for the waiver of fees associated with up to three raffles per year per organization. Because the fee for raffles is based upon the anticipated value of the prize(s), staff recommends that fees be waived for the Reverse raffle, Holiday Social and one of the split the pot raffles. The value of prizes for each split the pot raffle is not expected to exceed \$500 (total amount of \$1,000 in the pot) the license fee is \$10.00. Total fees for the remaining five to six raffles will be \$50.00 to \$60.00.

Staff recommends issuance of up to seven raffle licenses for monthly split the pot raffles at Chamber of Commerce luncheons. In addition, staff recommends waiver of the license fee for one raffle and waiver of fidelity bond requirements for up to seven raffles. This authorization will enable staff to work administratively with the Chamber of Commerce to issue licenses for monthly split the pot raffles. Licensing for the Reverse raffle and Holiday Social raffle will be handled independently.


