DECLARATION NO. 20-3

EXTENSION OF DECLARATION OF A STATE OF EMERGENCY IN THE VILLAGE OF CAROL STREAM, DUPAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS (COVID-19 – April 20, 2020)

- WHEREAS, the Village of Carol Stream ("Village") is a home rule unit of local government as provided by Article VII, Section 7 of the Illinois Constitution of 1970; and
- WHEREAS, on March 9, 2020, the Governor of the State of Illinois issued a Gubernatorial Disaster Proclamation in the State of Illinois related to the outbreak of Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19); and
- WHEREAS, on March 11, 2020, the Word Health Organization declared the COVID-19 virus a pandemic; and
- WHEREAS, on March 13, 2020, the President of the United States declared a nationwide emergency under Section 501(b) of the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act, 52 U.S.C. 5121, et seq., related to the COVID-19 pandemic; and
- WHEREAS, on March 16, 2020, the President of the DuPage County Board of Commissioners issued a disaster proclamation in DuPage County, Illinois related to the COVID-19 pandemic; and
- WHEREAS, on March 29, 2020 the President of the United States extended the federal social distancing guidelines until April 30, 2020; and
- WHEREAS, on March 31, 2020, The Governor of the State of Illinois extended his "stay at home" Executive Order until April 30, 2020; and
- WHEREAS, COVID-19 continues to be a dangerous disease which has spread around the world, including in the United States, the State of Illinois and DuPage County and is a direct and serious threat to the public's health, safety and welfare; and
- WHEREAS, COVID-19 pandemic is a contagious disease that is likely to cause loss of life, loss of productivity, hardship and suffering to persons residing in or doing business in and around the Village and constitutes a disaster; and
- WHEREAS, an extension of the declaration of disaster and state of civil emergency in the Village originally issued on March 19, 2020 is necessary in order to allow the Village to assist in preventing the loss of life and injuries, alleviating damages, loss, hardship and suffering related to the COVID-19 pandemic;
- **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT DECLARED,** under oath by the Mayor of the Village of Carol Stream, DuPage County, Illinois:

- <u>SECTION 1</u>: Incorporation. That the recitals above shall be and are incorporated in this Section 1 as if restated herein.
- SECTION 2: Extension of the Disaster Proclamation Declaration of a State of Emergency. Pursuant to the authority granted to the Mayor by law, it is hereby proclaimed that the COVID-19 pandemic continues to constitute a disaster and the state of civil emergency is hereby extended in the Village of Carol Stream, DuPage County, Illinois, effective April 20, 2020.
- **SECTION 3:** Emergency Powers. That the Mayor and Board of Trustees shall have such emergency powers as are provided to each of them under law.
- <u>SECTION 4</u>: Extension of Executive Orders. That all Executive Orders issued pursuant to the Declaration of Emergency are hereby extended.
- SECTION 4: Duration. That the state of emergency declared herein shall expire upon the earlier of (a) the adjournment of the next regular meeting of the Mayor and Board of Trustees, or (b) withdrawal of this Declaration by the Mayor.

SECTION 6: Filing. That this declaration shall be filed with the Village Clerk upon its execution by the Mayor.
