


Section II: Illini Drive to Thunderbird Trail







Improvements to channel flow and culvert capacity between Illini and the treatment plant facility. The following improvements are recommended as a first priority basis:

Illini-culvert	18 x 6	\$30,000.00
Thunderbird	20 x 6	\$32,000.00
Treatment Plant	20 x 6	\$16,000.00

The channel must be deepened beginning from Thunderbird to a depth of 1.5 feet at Illini to provide the depth for the culvert at Illini.




PRIVATE STREAMBANK STABILIZATION


