AUDIENCE PARTICIPATION AND PUBLIC HEARINGS:

Presentation of Check from Police Department Volunteers:

Sgt. Tom Miller described volunteer efforts performed in 2011. The Police Department presented a check for \$51,394.00 to Mayor Saverino symbolizing the 2,465 hours of service that the volunteers worked in 2011. The Village Board expressed its gratitude to the volunteers for their tireless efforts providing vital services to the Village.

West Suburban Fire/Rescue Alliance:

Fire Chief Rick Kolomay gave a Power Point presentation and provided information on the West Suburban Fire/Rescue Alliance. Chief Kolomay stated the Alliance consists of the Carol Stream, West Chicago and Winfield Fire Protection Districts and the Wheaton Fire Department. The purpose of the Alliance is not to consolidate agencies but rather to:

- Improve emergency services to residents
- Reduce operational and administrative costs
- Identify common communications and dispatch procedures
- Share common resources and services to reduce costs and improve response times
- Identify methods of increasing safety for response personnel

The Village Board expressed unanimous support for this ground breaking effort.

The following are brief descriptions of those items approved on the Consent Agenda for this meeting.

2012 Town Center Events - Amplification Permit/Sponsorship Appeal:

The report summarizes 2012 Summer Concert Series sponsorship effort, details recommended entertainment selections and request an amplification permit for 10 summer concerts, a 4-day carnival and the 7th Annual Teen Music Festival.

Approval Requested for Purchase of CST Vehicle:

The Village Board approved the Police Department request to purchase a Dodge RAM 150 crew heavy Service 4x4 CST pickup truck under the Southwest Conference of Mayors Cooperative bid in the amount of \$23,322.

2012-13 Vehicle Sticker Design:

The Village Board approved the "Shop Carol Stream" logo for the new vehicle sticker.

Ordinance No. 2012-02-06, Establishing the North Avenue and Schmale Road Tax Increment Financing District Fund, Amending the Fiscal Year 2011/12 Village Budget to Establish Budgetary Authority for Said Fund, and Transferring TIF Eligible Costs Previously Incurred to Said Fund:

The Village Board approved Ordinance No. 2012-02-06, establishing the North Avenue and Schmale Road Tax Increment Financing District Fund, amending the Fiscal Year 2011/12 Village Budget to establish budgetary authority for said fund, and transferring TIF eligible costs previously incurred to said fund. This ordinance authorizes staff to perform routine accounting actions and transfers needed to set up the new TIF fund in the Village's financial reporting structure.

Ordinance No. 2012-02-07, Approving a Special Use Permit to Allow a Garage and Parking Lot Not Incidental to a Permitted Use in the I Industrial Zoning District (Demar Logistics, Inc. 500 Kehoe Boulevard):

This is a request for zoning approval for the property owner to continue to lease a portion of the parking lot to Demar Logistics for use in storing trucks. The Village Board approved Ordinance No. 2012-02-07, approving a special use permit to allow a garage and Parking Lot Not Incidental to a permitted use in the I Industrial Zoning District (Demar Logistics, Inc. 500 Kehoe Boulevard).

Resolution No. 2573, Authorizing the Location, Construction, Operation and Maintenance of Village Infrastructure within the Jurisdiction of the Department of Transportation of the State of Illinois:

Every two years IDOT requires that municipal agencies adopt a resolution which authorizes local agencies to perform work within IDOT rights-of-way. The Village Board approved Resolution No. 2573, authorizing the location, construction, operation and maintenance of Village infrastructure within the jurisdiction of the Department of Transportation of the State of Illinois.

Resolution No. 2574, Authorizing the Execution of the Official Zoning Map of the Village of Carol Stream:

The Village Board approved the Village's Official Zoning Map, which is required to be done by March 31st each year.

Resolution No. 2575, of Support for the West Suburban Fire/Rescue Alliance:

The Village Board approved Resolution No. 2575, supporting the West Suburban Fire/Rescue Alliance.

DuPage Community Development Commission Appointment:

The Village Board approved the request to appoint Assistant Community Development Director Don Bastian to the DuPage Community Development Commission.

Approval of Settlement Agreement - Hunter Gilmore Matter:

This item was removed from the agenda.

Regular Bills and Addendum Warrant of Bills:

The Village Board approved the payment of the Regular Bills dated February 21, 2012 in the amount of \$239,955.85.
