

Commissioner Spink moved and Commissioner Petella made the second to open the Public Hearing.

#### Case # 16089, Village of Carol Stream - 500 N. Gary Avenue

Amendments to the Village of Carol Stream Comprehensive Plan

Chairman Parisi swore in the witness, John T. Carlisle, Assistant Planner Chicago Metropolitan Agency for Planning (CMAP), 233 South Wacker Drive, Chicago, IL. Mr. Carlisle gave a power point presentation of the Carol Stream Comprehensive Plan. The presentation included the different phases of the process in creating the Comprehensive Plan:

- Community Outreach Steering committee, interviews, focus groups and public visioning workshops.
- Issues they heard from the groups Lack of central place, where does Carol Stream start and end, flooding protection.
- Visions they heard from the groups Strengthen local character, foster business growth, improve transportation network, especially support walking and biking.

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Mr. Carlisle talked about the plan structure chapter topics: Vision, Land Use, Economic Development, Housing, Transportation, Natural Resources, Image & Identity, Next Steps and the Future Land Use Map.

Chairman Parisi asks for any questions from the audience.

Mr. Marc Spallina from MJS Corporate Real Estate Services is the broker for the property on North Avenue and Bennett Drive and was glad to see that CMAP is recommending that this property be zoned a mixed use. This type of zoning will make the property more attractive to buyers and developers.

Chairman Parisi asks Mr. Farace for the staff report. Mr. Farace stated that the comprehensive plan is the main document for the community and staff is excited to have an updated plan. He stated that staff believes that the plan touches upon the main points: land use, transportation, economic development, housing and natural resources initiatives. He stated that staff is recommending approval of the amendments to the comprehensive plan.

Chairman Parisi asks Commissioners for any questions.

Commissioner Petella did not have any questions, and he thanked everyone that worked on the amendments to the Comprehensive Plan.

Commissioner Spink pointed out some typographical errors and thanked everyone that worked on the amendments to the Comprehensive Plan.

Community Development Director, Donald Bastian stated that staff will work with CMAP to have the typographical errors corrected.

Commissioner Creighton stated that he would like to see staff provide comments in staff reports on how a future project aligns with the comprehensive plan. Commissioner Creighton wanted to know what the village could do to encourage the type of development suggested in the comprehensive plan for the North Avenue and County Farm Road intersection properties that have already been developed and are unincorporated. Commissioner Creighton wanted to know if the visitability principles listed on page 54 of the comprehensive plan only applied to new construction. Commissioner Creighton stated that he would like to see annual report that summarizes implementation and activities and highlights for upcoming activities from staff. Commissioner Creighton wanted to know why we are amending the old comprehensive plan. Commissioner Creighton also thanked everyone involved in the development of the amended comprehensive plan.

Mr. Carlisle stated that with village staff that is readily available and staff will have some momentum behind the community development vision with the creation of the new comprehensive plan that should be enough to grant a little bit of interest from people who may be interested in purchasing and redeveloping the properties. Mr. Carlisle stated that he believes that the visitability principle does not only apply to new construction and it could also include retrofitting to existing homes.

Mr. Bastian stated that the reason we need to amend the comprehensive plan is the village already has a comprehensive plan from 1980 and the notation is to amend the 1980 plan and have this updated plan in its place and have the village board adopt the new comprehensive plan.

Commissioner Tucek wanted to know once the comprehensive plan is adopted who takes ownership of the plan. Commissioner Tucek also wanted to thank everyone involved in the development of the amended comprehensive plan.

Mr. Bastian stated that it will be staff's job in Community Development to keep the comprehensive plan in the forefront and visible and refer back to the plan when we have meetings with developers. Mr.

Bastian stated that staff will be adding a section to staff reports stating how the project complies with the comprehensive plan.

Chairman Parisi also thanked everyone involved in the development of the amended comprehensive plan. Chairman Parisi stated that when a proposed plan comes before the plan commission he would encourage the plan commission members to review the plan to see if it complies with the comprehensive plan.

Commissioner Petella moved and Commissioner Spink made the second to approve the request with Commissioners Creighton's recommendations for an annual report that summarizes implementation and activities and a report of highlights upcoming activities from staff.

#### **PROCLAMATION**

#### Celebrating the 40th Anniversary of the Carol Stream Historical Society

**WHEREAS**, the Carol Stream Historical Society was founded in 1976 for the purpose of celebrating the Nation's Bi-Centennial; and

**WHEREAS**, the Carol Stream Historical Society is comprised of volunteers who share the passion of preserving and presenting the history of the community; and

**WHEREAS,** the goal of the Carol Stream Historical Society is to preserve the history of the area of Carol Stream as well as to educate and inform the public of that history and to acquire, collect and preserve artifacts of historical significance; and

**WHEREAS,** the projects of the Society include the Historic Farmhouse on Lies Road, the Gretna Museum and Caboose located at Armstrong Park; and

**WHEREAS**, Village officials and members of the Carol Stream Historical Society formally dedicated the Historic Farmhouse for education and public use on September 12, 2002 and dedicated Gretna Station on July 4, 1976; and

**WHEREAS**, the Carol Stream Historical Society conducts tours and holds special event days, gives presentations to local schools on community history, sponsors lectures and exhibits, cooperates with other organizations that share its goals and concerns and endeavors to archive and protect surviving records and personal collections relating to Carol Stream; and

Approval to purchase two (2) replacement squad cars

The Police Department requests approval to purchase one (1) Special Operations squad and one (1) Patrol squad from Thomas Dodge.

The department has identified the need to replace Special Operations squad 694. This is consistent with our vehicle replacement plan that systematically identifies vehicles that are reaching their optimal service life. Squad 694, a 2009 Ford Crown Victoria, has reached the end of its service life. This vehicle is 7 years old and currently has over 64,000 miles on it. By the time the replacement squad is received and up-fitted, 694 will reach the target mileage of 75,000. Due to its age, it is becoming mechanically unsound for heavy service police use. Its primary use was by the Special Operations Unit for tactical patrol. Squad 694 will continue to be utilized for several months until its replacement can be outfitted properly and entered into the fleet. Eventually, Squad 694 will be declared surplus and auctioned.

Squad 622 is the first Dodge Charger that we purchased to replace the outgoing Ford Crown Victoria. Squad 622 has spent its entire life as a zone car on daily patrol. It currently has over 75,000 miles on it and has reached the end of its service life. It will remain in service as a back-up squad until its replacement is received, up-fitted and placed into service. The process of ordering, receiving and up-fitting a new police vehicle can take up to 6 months.

I propose that we replace 694 and 622 with two (2) new 2016 Dodge Charger Police Pursuit vehicles under the Southwest Conference of Mayors Cooperative bid, for a price of \$26,982 and \$26,737 (\$53,719 total). This price is below the budgeted amount for the vehicles. The cooperative vendor is Thomas Dodge, 9604 Indianapolis Blvd., Highland, IN 46322.

These new squads will be outfitted with a large, factory installed, in-dash touch screen that will allow us to mount the laptop in the trunk of the vehicle, thereby, creating much needed space within the cabin. This will also reduce the likelihood of damage to the laptop and injury to the officer should a crash occur. The new Chargers will be all-wheel drive, improving safety and drivability in foul weather. The new Chargers will be out-fitted with a factory installed back-up cameras and sensors to increase safety and reduce the incidents of backing crashes. Additionally, they will be outfitted with cutting edge Watchguard in-car camera systems. The Watchguard system records in high definition video. It consists of 3 camera heads that record simultaneously. One forward facing camera records in the standard 68 degree viewing angle. The second forward facing camera records in a pillar to pillar near 180-degree panoramic viewing angle. This camera will allow us to capture incidents that are often missed by the standard camera head. The audio recording capabilities of this system are also far superior to our outgoing system. Videos from this system will be wirelessly uploaded to our new Watchguard server system, greatly reducing the manhours required to manually uploading the videos.

Recommendation to Waive Bids and Award Contract.

In 2005, Engineering Staff worked with LaFayette Home Nursery to create a series of three-year plans for pond shoreline and wetland maintenance. Rather than awarding a three-year contract, it was decided to award each contract on a yearly basis. LaFayette Home Nursery went out of business in 2011.

Five years ago, engineering staff interviewed contractors to complete the unfinished work from LaFayette's contract, and decided to award the remaining work to Bedrock Earthscapes, LLC as a trial project. In order to control costs, we also awarded a separate contract to Wildland Management, Inc. to perform prairie burns.

Bedrock evaluated the condition of the vegetation, made maintenance recommendations and has done excellent work for the past five years. The work consists of high mowing, multiple herbicide applications and selective cutting. Last year also included spreading free prairie seed from Fermi Lab.

The selection of Bedrock Earthscapes, LLC was compared to previously bid pond shoreline maintenance projects, and offered a substantial saving over preceding contractors. Engineering Staff therefore recommends that the bid process be waived, and the 2016-2017 Pond Shoreline and Wetland Maintenance Contract be awarded to Bedrock Earthscapes, LLC for \$19,900.00.

Motion to Award a Contract for Emergency Street Light Repair Services -

H&H Electric Company

In April 2016 Public Works solicited bids for annual emergency street light repair services. This contract allows Public Works to have a contractor available to replace or repair damaged streetlights (typically from vehicle knockdowns). The scope of the work covered by this contract is typically beyond the capabilities of in-house staff.

Bid packets were sent to eight (8) interested contractors with four (4) companies returning bids. Public Works cannot predict exactly how many hours will be needed for each equipment and labor type, so bidders were instructed that we would apply the hourly rates submitted to an estimated number of hours for each cost type (see full bid tabulation attached). For bid evaluation purposes Public Works solicited hourly rates from vendors based upon our own historical usage of this type of emergency service. However, no work is guaranteed under the contract.

H&H Electric Company provided the lowest combined rates for the various labor and equipment types listed on the bid form. H&H has also satisfactorily provided these services to the Village for the past four years. A copy of the bid submitted by H&H is attached.

Therefore, it is recommended that the Village Board approve a motion awarding a contract to H&H Electric Company for Emergency Street Light Repair Services for the period June 1, 2016, through April 30, 2017.

In January 2013, the Village entered into a 48-month agreement with the Xerox Corporation to lease a multifunction copier that aside from providing document reproduction service also has fax, scanning and document archiving capabilities as well. The current machine under lease is nearing the end of its useful life and frequent calls for maintenance service to the unit has rendered its reliability to the Village going forward as uncertain. The lease agreement for the current Xerox unit will expire on December 31, 2016.

A group of employees from key user departments that includes Administration and Community Development were tasked with researching several of the current highly-rated multi-function units on the market as candidates for replacement. The workgroup identified comparable medium volume replacement models manufactured by Ricoh, Canon USA and Xerox as well. Field visits to the manufacturer showrooms to demo the models under consideration were conducted in March and April. The workgroup subsequently met to discuss their respective evaluation of the targeted models that were followed by requests by the dealers/manufacturers for formal lease proposals. A summary of the lease proposals for a 36-month Fair Market Value lease agreement are detailed below:

The workgroup met in late April to review the formal lease proposals and unanimously agreed to recommend the Canon Image Runner Advance C7270 machine as the preferred model to replace the existing Xerox unit. Aside from the affordable lease terms, the

recommended Canon unit was rated favorably in the key areas that include speed, document clarity, color resolution, fax and scanning capabilities as well as the ease of use of the unit's interface and smart design and intuitive navigation features. In replacing the current Xerox with the recommended Canon multifunction device, the Village's 1-year reproduction costs will decrease by 29% (\$4,347) and 33% (\$15,795) over the course of the 36-month lease period. Attached is the formal proposal from Canon USA Direct as well as a BLI Industry Award naming Canon as the product line of the year with respect to multifunction devices.

Staff recommends waiving competitive bidding and enter into a 36-month fair market value agreement to lease a Canon Image Runner C7270 at an annual lease charge of \$10,308 per month as well as the per copy quarterly overage charges for black & white (30,000/qtr. Free) and color reproductions (18,000/qtr. Free). The quoted lease price is inclusive of delivery, installation training, replenishable supplies and service. Please include this on the May 16<sup>th</sup> agenda for consideration by the Village Board.


